- \* Talk to your pet; call him by his name. You may want to play soft music for him when he's alone.

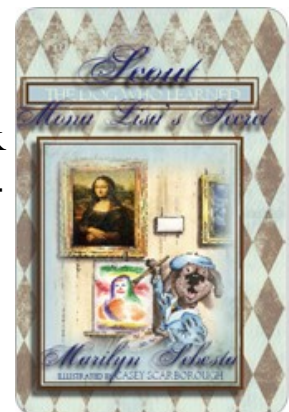

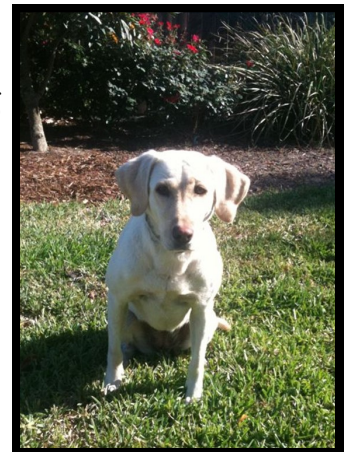
## This Issue's Winner
